

Dear Parents/ Guardians,

Glasgow Middle is pleased to announce a Geometry summer course for high school credit! Current EBR students who have completed Algebra I during the 2018-2019 school year and have scored an Advanced on the LEAP 2025 in Algebra I are eligible for this accelerated summer course (additional criteria listed below). Due to the nature of the accelerated time frame, students will be required to complete coursework through the computer program Edgenuity. During the daily scheduled class time, students will have the opportunity to work with a certified geometry teacher. Coursework will be completed at home as well as at school. Students will be required to complete and pass in its entirety the Geometry Edgenuity coursework prior to taking the LEAP 2025 on June 20th. **The grades the student receives in the two sessions of the Geometry course through Edgenuity will appear on the student's transcript.** Students will only earn the high school credit if the Edgenuity coursework is completed and passed. Students must also take and pass the LEAP 2025 in Geometry to earn credit. High schools will not accept a BASIC or below score on Geometry LEAP 2025. MASTERY and ADVANCED scores only.

Program Details and Important Information:

- Students must have met the following criteria:
 - a. Passed Algebra I with at least two A's and no grade lower than B over the course of the first three 9 weeks.
 - b. Scored an ADVANCED on the Algebra I LEAP 2025
 - c. Must have approval of principal and Algebra I teacher
 - d. *Payment for course will be due upon receipt of LEAP 2025 scores. Payment is due by May 22nd.*
- Dates and Times: Daily classes 8 A.M.- 12 P.M. Monday -Thursday beginning Tuesday, May 28th and ending Thursday, June 20th (LEAP 2025 date).
- Parents must provide transportation.
- Students will wear the uniform of their home school.
- Free breakfast and lunch will be provided by EBR- Glasgow Middle Summer Meals program.
- Orientation to the class, the Edgenuity program, and other details will be held prior to the start date of the course. Time and date will be announced closer to the beginning of the course.
- The last day to register is Friday, May 17th. Please fill out the registration page and bring payment upon time of registration. *Payment is due by May 22nd.*
- The cost for this program is \$275.00 per student. ***The cost is non-refundable once the student has registered. Payment must be cash or money order. NO CHECKS.***
