



# HELP US TEST STATE-OF-THE-ART IMAGING MACHINES.

Medical imaging systems can take a look inside areas of our bodies hidden by our skin and bones. Through the **Shape Up Kids research study**, scientists at Pennington Biomedical are exploring new ways to use some of these advanced 3D imaging systems.

Researchers will test if the imaging machines can provide useful information about early signs of diseases such as cardiovascular disease - a condition that can lead to heart problems.

The **Shape Up Kids research study** includes one visit to the Pennington Biomedical outpatient clinic that will last approximately 4.5 hours.

## To qualify for this research study, participants should:

- Be ages 5 to 17 years old
- Not have medical implants such as a pacemaker or metal joint replacement

Compensation of up to \$50 is offered for completion of the study.
