

Dear Gator Parents,

The faculty, staff, and students of Glasgow Middle have been preparing for the LEAP 2025 state testing since August! In this unprecedented school year, we realize that you may have additional questions and concerns surrounding state testing. With that in mind, we wanted to share with you our testing schedule and our plan to ensure the safety and health of our Gator family.

Glasgow Middle will begin testing on Tuesday, April 27th. We will test students by grade level groupings during assigned weeks. This will allow us to follow current CDC guidelines and ensure social distancing. The following detailed schedule will carry our students through the remainder of the year.

6th Grade Schedule for April 26-May 20 (approximately 200 students)

- April 26: All 6th, 7th, & 8th Graders Regular Schedule
- April 27-30: All 6th Grade Return to Campus for State Testing
- May 3-7: All 6th Grade will be virtual for 7th and 8th Graders to Test
- May 10- End of the Year: All 6th, 7th, & 8th Graders Regular Schedule

7th and 8th Grade Schedule for April 26-May 20 (approximately 300 students)

- April 26: All 6th, 7th, & 8th Graders Regular Schedule
- April 27-30: All 7th and 8th Grade will be virtual for 6th Graders to Test
- May 3-7: All 7th and 8th Grade Return to Campus for State Testing
- May 10- End of the Year: All 6th, 7th, & 8th Graders Regular Schedule

We will utilize ALL faculty and staff members on campus to test students each testing week. This will allow for smaller testing groups and social distancing. This same information can also be found on the reverse of this page in a calendar format. This information will also be part of our April monthly newsletter and calendar that will go home on Thursday, April 1st.

Additionally, the following items should be kept in mind:

- **ALL VIRTUAL STUDENTS MUST RETURN ON CAMPUS TO TEST** during the assigned testing week. The Louisiana Department of Education has not given a waiver or allowed for students to take the LEAP remotely. If the student does not take the LEAP 2025, he/she will receive a zero on this state test.
- The school day begins at 6:50. We will begin moving students to the testing room at 7:15. **STUDENTS MUST BE ON TIME.** If you need your child's bus information, please contact us at Glasgow Middle prior to the testing date, 225-925-2942.
- Students will need their chromebook, the charger, and an AR book. Students will NOT need a booksack. All testing materials needed will be provided to the students. Students need to make sure that chromebooks are charged prior to their arrival on campus.
- Students can bring a thermos or water bottle and their lunch box. Students DO NOT need to bring snacks.
- Students will be socially distanced with the required protocols in place. Testing groups will not exceed the spacing guidelines as determined by the size of the room. All faculty and staff members will be utilized to test students. Keeping our testing groups within the prescribed guidelines.
- While students are virtual, they will continue to prepare for testing via independent work. Students will also be permitted to complete any unfinished assignments that may be needed. No new instruction will be delivered. Information for each class will be posted to Google Classroom.
