The online <u>Magnet School Application</u> period opens on **September 25th**. To complete an application for the Magnet Program:

- 1. Choose a Magnet Program.
- 2. Review the program's entrance requirements
- 3. Complete the online application process.
- 4. Submit the online application within three (3) days of beginning the process.
- 5. Deliver a copy of the signature page, including proofs of residency, (an affidavit, if applicable) to the first-choice school within four (4) days of the online submission date.
