

2026 Math Placement Test

Who should take the placement test?

All students who will be new to Glasgow are welcome to take the math placement test. Students interested in enrolling in Glasgow's Gifted, Scholastic Academy, or Great Scholars programs are strongly encouraged to take the test. Students who are currently enrolled at Glasgow should not register.

When is the test?

The test will be administered at Glasgow Middle School on Saturday, May 9 at 8:00 AM. Parents need to register for the math placement test using the form on the Registration Information page of the school website (www.glasgowmiddle.org). Please register by May 1, 2026.

Why do students need to take the placement test?

Using district criteria, students will be placed in math classes based on their performance on the placement test and their recent standardized test data. Students will be placed in Math 6, Math 7, Math 8 (Introduction to Algebra), or Algebra I.

How long will the test last?

Students will have two hours to complete the test.

What will be on the test?

The test will cover state standards from sixth grade, seventh grade, and eighth grade math. If you would like more information about these standards, you may review K-12 Louisiana Student Standards for Math on the Louisiana Department of Education website (<http://www.louisianabelieves.com/resources/library/academic-standards>).

What should students bring to the testing session?

Students should bring two sharpened pencils with good erasers. All other items necessary to complete the test (calculators, rulers, protractors, scratch paper, etc.) will be provided.
